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IBCP Requirements

- Successful completion of a West High School career pathway.
- Successful completion of 2 IB Diploma Courses and Exams related to the chosen career pathway.
- Personal and Professional Skills Course
- Language Development Course
- Service Learning
- Reflective Project

West High School provides flexible learning opportunities to serve the whole student.

Students may choose a Career Pathway from 32 different options in 8 career and technical areas: Agricultural Education, Business Education, Engineering & Technology Education, Family and Consumer Sciences, Health Sciences, Information Technology, Marketing Education, Skilled and Technical Education. A Career Pathway is comprised of 3 years of study in the same career field.

West High School is working with the local community to gain increased recognition for the IBCP.

Students may choose IB Courses from 27 different pathway options. Six languages are taught at West, each of which will satisfy the Language Development Course requirements.
