- 6 IB Courses in 11th & 12th grades
Courses are across all curricular areas (English, World Language, Social Studies, Science, Math, Fine Arts)
- Theory of Knowledge Course (TOK)

- Creativity, Action & Service (CAS)
18 months of student learning outside of the classroom
- Extended Essay (EE)
4000 word college level paper on any topic of student interest

IB Career-Related Program

- Completion of a Career Pathway
3 years of study in a chosen career field
- 2 IB Courses in 11th & 12th grades
Courses are selected from all curricular areas related to the student's selected career field
- Personal and Professional Skills (PPS)
How do we interact effectively and ethically in the work place?
- Service Learning
50 hours of student developed service activities related to the career field
- Reflective Project (RP)
Written, visual, or oral presentation of an ethical dilemma in the student's career field
- Language Development
50 hours of world language study related to the student's career field
