 - i. Julie was not able to attend, but sent an update with Kim. (see 1&2 below)
 - 1. "The Reflections theme this year is "Within Reach" and entries are due to Ms. Delfin in Room B-311 by the end of school on Thursday, November 16th. An announcement has been posted on the West High website, fliers have been taped up around the school, and all related faculty (arts, dance, and English) have received information about the contest in their faculty mailboxes. Student senate is in the process of making some big posters to hang up around the school, and a weekly announcement is being made on the morning announcements (although the last two weeks, this hasn't happened despite our request --I'm looking into this). The announcement will be made more frequently on the morning announcements as the deadline approaches."

- a. Community Partnerships.....Lisa Thompson
 - i. A huge thank you to Lisa who no longer has a student at West, but has so graciously agreed to remain on the PTSA Board with the focus on how PTSA & West can better serve our community.
 - 1. Current known needs: food pantry, laundry, & shower facilities (to keep in mind for the eventual rebuild)

ii. Food Bank

- 1. Distributing food is a distraction during the day & difficult to staff hours in the evenings. Once the PTSA knows when it should be open, we can help clean & organize it as well as staff it regularly. It's currently in the old Cinderella's Closet room.
 - a. Maybe community groups &/or IB students needing CAS hours can regularly staff it?
 - b. National Honor Society may help organize a regular 15 min. drop-off period on Tuesdays. Possibly use the loop by the W/cafeteria doors? Maybe have student gov't do an AM drop & another group an after school pm collection?
- iii. Broader PTSA Representation more neighborhood families are needed to better represent the community's interests & needs
 - Lisa will reach out to University Neighborhood Partners to see if they
 have ideas or models that we could use to reach out to the West High
 Community.
 - 2. Our Casa is a space meant to welcome families, share information, have meetings, etc. Classes on stress, mental health, etc. will begin soon.
 - a. Our Casa's & its programs are an initiative from the U of Utah.
 - 3. Possibly hold the last PTSA meeting of the year at Northwest to recruit families
 - a. PTSA may need to inquire about the day & time PTSA meets to see if there is a more accommodating schedule for families. Will day care be needed?
 - 4. Lisa T. will check in monthly about initiatives & meet w/ Lisa S. from the Family Resource Center (FRC), Pam, & Kim
